

# LUKE 12 vs 1

Dr. Luke ended the last chapter saying: when Jesus left wherever He was, the scribes and Pharisees began to oppose Him vigorously, and to provoke Him to speak on many things: to ambush Him, seeking to trap Him with something He said, that they might accuse Him

And though Jesus was rejected by the religious elite, He continued teaching the massive crowds who gathered around Him.

**<sup>1</sup> At this time, a crowd gathered together so numerous, that they were trampling on one another, and He began to say to His disciples first of all, Be wary of the leavening influence of the Pharisees, which is hypocrisy.**

**<sup>2</sup> For there is nothing covered, that will not be revealed; nothing hid, that will not be made known.**

**<sup>3</sup> So whatever you have said in the dark will be heard in the light; and what you have whispered in the ear in private, will be proclaimed on the housetops.**

Fear God,

**<sup>4</sup> And I say to you My friends, Do not fear those who can kill the body, and after that can do nothing more.**

**<sup>5</sup> But I will show you the One to fear: Fear Him, who after He has killed, has authority to throw into hell; yes, I say to you, Fear Him.**

**<sup>6</sup> Are not five sparrows sold for two pennies? yet not one of them is forgotten in God's sight.**

**<sup>7</sup> Indeed, the hairs of your head are all counted. So do not be anxious: you are of more value than many sparrows.**

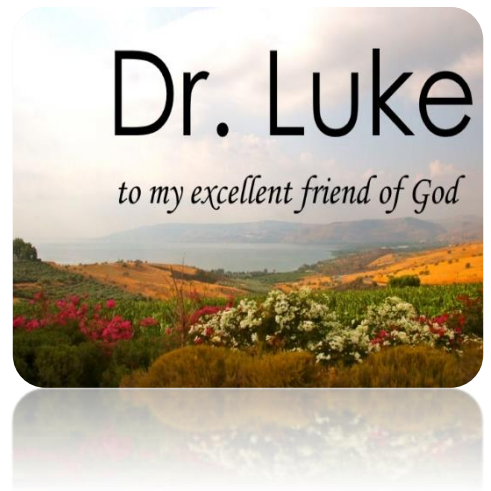
Acknowledging Christ, the Messiah,

**<sup>8</sup> I also say to you, Whoever will confess Me before men,**

**that one will the Son of Man also confess before the angels of God:**

**<sup>9</sup> but he who denies Me before men will be denied before the angels of God.**

**<sup>10</sup> And whoever will speak a word against the Son of Man will be forgiven: but the one who blasphemes against the Holy Spirit will not be forgiven.**



# LUKE 12 vs 1

**11 And when they bring you before the synagogues, and rulers and authorities, do not be anxious how you should answer, or what you will say:**

**12 For the Holy Spirit will tell you at that same hour what you should say.**

Concerning greed,

**13 And someone of the crowd said to Him, Teacher, tell my brother to divide the inheritance with me.**

**14 And He said to him, Friend, who made Me a judge or referee over you?**

**15 And He said to them, Watch out, and be wary of all greed: for the life of a man does not consist in the abundance of the things he possesses.**

**16 And He told them a parable, saying, The land of a rich man brought forth abundantly:**

**17 and he thought to himself, What should I do, since I have no place to store my fruits?**

**18 And he said, This is what I will do: I will tear down my barns, and build bigger ones; and there I will store all my fruits and my goods.**

**19 Then I will say to myself, you have many goods stored up for many years; so take it easy, eat, drink, and be merry / take a break and celebrate.**

**20 But God said to him, You fool, this very night your life is demanded of you: and all the things you have provided -- who will those things belong to?**

**21 That is how it is for one who lays up treasure for himself, and is not rich toward God.**

**22 And He said to His disciples / to those doing their math, putting it all together, piece by piece, For this reason I say to you, Do not be anxious about your life, what you will eat; or for the body, what you will wear.**

**23 The life is more than food, and the body is more than clothes.**

**24 Consider the ravens: they do not sow or reap; they have no storehouse or barn; yet God feeds them: and aren't you worth more than the birds?**

**25 And can anyone add a cubit to his height, being anxious?**

**26 If then you are not able to do a little thing, why be anxious for the rest?**

<sup>27</sup> Consider how the lilies grow: they do not labor or spin thread; and yet I tell you, that Solomon in all his splendor was not adorned like one of these.

<sup>28</sup> If God so clothes the grass, that is in the field today, and is thrown in the furnace tomorrow; how much more will He clothe you -- you of little faith?

<sup>29</sup> Do not keep looking for what you will eat or what you will drink, do not be anxious.

<sup>30</sup> For all these things do the nations of the world seek after: and your Father knows you need these things.

<sup>31</sup> But rather, **seek the kingdom of God**; and all these little things will be added to you.
