LUKE 21 vs 1




In this chapter Luke presents the prophecy of Jesus regarding future events which has captured the attention of Gentile nations for 2,000 years. But first...

- ¹ And He looked up, and saw the rich casting their gifts into the treasury.
- ² And He saw a certain poor widow / whom Jesus just said hypocritical religious leaders usually target to plunder their property... and things don't change much, it's a practice still encouraged today;

casting in there... two mites / 2 small coins.

³ And He said, truly I say to you,

this poor widow has cast in more than they all:



⁴ For all these have of their abundance cast into the offerings of God:

but she of her poverty... has cast in all the living that she had.

Dr. John MacArthur asks, did this widow's action please the Lord? Did her action anger the Lord? This story finds its place in scripture inserted between the utter condemnation of Jesus on a corrupt religious system... built on endless manmade traditions...including misguided burdening the poor; rather than on what the word of God declared.

Did she believe it was required in the law?
