
LUKE 22 vs 21



This Tuesday night of **Passover**, when Jesus, the Lamb of God was betrayed, the **first** of seven days that specially belong to the Lord; seven days that Moses told us all about it -- Leviticus 23: And Dr. Luke in great detail tells us, that still in the upper room, Jesus said...

- ²¹ But look, the hand of the one who betrays Me is at the table.
- ²² And truly the Son of Man will go away as it was determined: but woe / how terrible it will be for that man by whom He is betrayed!
- ²³ And they began to argue among themselves, who of them it could be who was going to do this thing.
- ²⁴ Then a dispute arose among them, who should be considered the greatest.
- ²⁵ But He said to them, The kings of the Gentiles seek to dominate over them; and those who have authority over them are called benefactors.



Day 1: Passover

- ²⁶ But it must **not** be like that among you: but whoever is greatest among you, let him be as the younger; and whoever is chief, as he who serves.
- ²⁷ For who is greater, the one sitting at the dinner table, or the one who serves? Is it not the one sitting at the table? But I am among you as the One who serves.
- ²⁸ You are the ones who have stood by Me in My testings / in His trials.
- ²⁹ And I bestow on you a kingdom, as My Father bestowed on Me;
- ³⁰ so that you may eat and drink at My table in My kingdom,

and you will sit on thrones judging the twelve tribes of Israel / and can't you hear them say, what is He talking about? Sitting where? doing what?

31 And the Lord said, Simon, Simon,

Pay attention, Satan desires to sift you like wheat:

³² But I have prayed for you, that your faith does not fail:

but when you have turned around, strengthen your brothers / when you return to your senses; and did Jesus just look at Peter while He pointed to all those gathered in that upper room?

- ³³ And he told Him, Lord, I am ready to go with You, both to prison and to death.
- 34 And He said, I tell you Peter, the rooster will not crow today, before you deny three times that you know Me.

Be ready for trouble,

- ³⁵ Then He said to them, When I sent you without a wallet and shepherd-bag and sandals did you lack anything? And they said, Nothing / on their first mission, they had all they needed.
- ³⁶ Then He said to them: But now, whoever has a wallet, take it, and also a shepherd-bag: and whoever has no sword, go sell his robe and buy one.
- ³⁷ For I tell you, what is written must be fulfilled in Me, that He was numbered among the criminals Isaiah 53:12: for what is written about Me will soon be fulfilled.
- ³⁸ And they said, Lord, Look, here are two swords. And He told them, It is enough.
- ³⁹ He went out as usual, and went to the Mount of Olives; and His disciples also joined Him.
- ⁴⁰ And when He arrived at the place, He said to them, Pray that you do not enter into temptation. ⁴¹ And He withdrew from them about a stone's throw, and knelt down, and prayed,
- ⁴² Saying, Father, if You are willing, take this cup from Me: yet not My will, but Yours be done.



- 43 Then an angel from heaven appeared to Him, strengthening Him.
- ⁴⁴ And being in agony He prayed more fervently: and <u>His sweat was as great drops of blood</u> falling to the ground / Hematidrosis, a rare condition experienced by humans under extreme duress.
- 45 And when He got up from prayer, and went to His disciples, He found them sleeping due to grief,
- ⁴⁶ He asked them, Why are you sleeping? Get up and pray, so that you will not be tempted.
