This Tuesday night of **Passover**, when Jesus, the Lamb of God was betrayed, the **first** of **seven days that specially belong to the Lord**; seven days that Moses told us all about it -- **Leviticus 23**: And Dr. Luke in great detail tells us, that still in the upper room, Jesus said...

**21 But look, the hand of the one who betrays Me is at the table.**

**22 And truly the Son of Man will go away as it was determined: but woe / how terrible it will be for that man by whom He is betrayed!**

**23 And they began to argue among themselves, who of them it could be who was going to do this thing.**

**24 Then a dispute arose among them, who should be considered the greatest.**

**25 But He said to them, The kings of the Gentiles seek to dominate over them; and those who have authority over them are called benefactors.**

**26 But it must **not** be like that among you: but whoever is greatest among you, let him be as the younger; and whoever is chief, as he who serves.**

**27 For who is greater, the one sitting at the dinner table, or the one who serves? Is it not the one sitting at the table? **But I am among you as the One who serves.****

**28 You are the ones who have stood by Me in My testings / in His trials.**

**29 And I bestow on you a kingdom, as My Father bestowed on Me;**

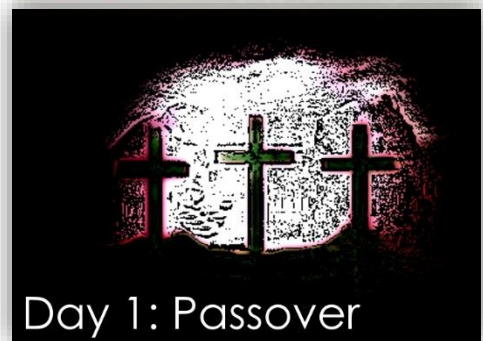
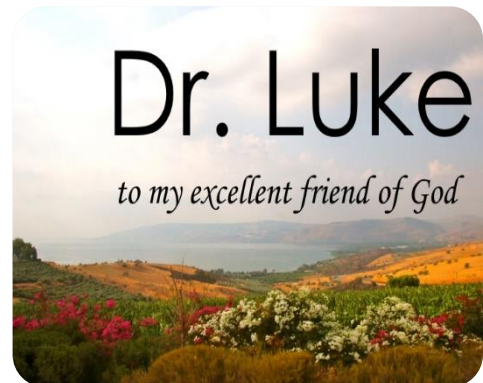
**30 so that you may eat and drink at My table in My kingdom,**

**and you will sit on thrones judging the twelve tribes of Israel / and can't you hear them say, what is He talking about? Sitting where? doing what?**

**31 And the Lord said, Simon, Simon,**

**32 **But I have prayed for you, that your faith does **not** fail:****

<sup>33</sup> And he told Him, Lord, I am ready to go with You, both to prison and to death.

<sup>34</sup> And He said, I tell you Peter, the rooster will **not** crow today, before you deny three times that you know Me.

<sup>35</sup> Then He said to them, When I sent you without a wallet and shepherd-bag and sandals did you lack anything? And they said, Nothing / on their first mission, they had all they needed.

<sup>36</sup> Then He said to them: But now, whoever has a wallet, take it, and also a shepherd-bag: and whoever has **no** sword, go sell his robe and buy one.

<sup>37</sup> For I tell you, what is written must be fulfilled in Me, that He was numbered among the criminals – **Isaiah 53:12**: for what is written about Me will soon be fulfilled.

<sup>38</sup> And they said, Lord, Look, here are two swords. And He told them, It is enough.

<sup>39</sup> He went out as usual, and went to **the Mount of Olives**; and His disciples also joined Him.

<sup>40</sup> And when He arrived at the place, He said to them, Pray that you do **not** enter into temptation.<sup>41</sup> And He withdrew from them about a stone's throw, and knelt down, and prayed,

<sup>42</sup> Saying, Father, if You are willing, take this cup from Me: yet **not** My will, but Yours be done.



<sup>43</sup> Then an angel from heaven appeared to Him, strengthening Him.

<sup>44</sup> And being in agony He prayed more fervently: and **His sweat was as great drops of blood falling to the ground** / Hematidrosis, a rare condition experienced by humans under extreme duress.

<sup>45</sup> And when He got up from prayer, and went to His disciples, He found them sleeping due to grief,

<sup>46</sup> He asked them, Why are you sleeping? Get up and pray, so that you will not be tempted.
