The Wind and Waves obey Jesus,

 22 ¶ And it came to pass on a certain day, that He went into a ship with His disciples, and He said to them, Let us go over to the other side of the lake. And they launched forth.

²³ And as they sailed, He fell asleep, and there came down a storm of wind on the lake, and they were filled with water, and were in jeopardy.

²⁴ Then they went to Him, and awoke Him, saying, Master, Master, we perish. And He arose, and rebuked the wind, and the waves of water: and they ceased, and it was calm.



²⁵ Then He said to them, Where is your faith? and they feared, and wondered among themselves, saying, Who is this that commands both the winds and water, and they obey Him!

 $^{26}\P$ So they sailed to the region of the Gadarenes, which is opposite Galilee.

²⁷ And as He went out, there He met a certain man from the city, who had demons for a long time, and he wore no clothes, neither live in house, but among the graves.

²⁸ And when he saw Jesus, he cried out, and fell down before Him, and with a loud voice said, What have I to do with you, Jesus the son of God the most High? I ask You do not torment me.

²⁹ For He commanded the demon to come out of the man: often it seized him: so he

was guarded and kept in chains: but he would break the restraints and be driven by the demon into the wildernesses.

³⁰ Then Jesus asked him, saying, What is your name? and he said, Legion, because many demons had entered into him.

³⁴ When the herdsmen saw what was done, they fled: and when they were departed, they told it in the city and in the region.

35 Then they came to see what happened, and came to Jesus, and found the man, out of whom the demons departed, sitting at the feet of Jesus, clothed, and in his right mind: and they were afraid.

³⁶ They also who saw it, told them how the one who was possessed with the demon, was healed.

³⁷ Then the whole crowd of the region around the Gadarenes, asked Him that He would leave them: for they were taken with a great fear: and He entered the ship, and left.

³⁸ Then the man, out of whom the demons depart asked Him if he might go with Him: but Jesus sent him away, saving,

³⁹ Return to your home, and show what great things God has done to you. So he went his way, and preached throughout all the city, what great things Jesus had done to him.

A woman healed, a young girl restored,

⁴⁰ And it happened, when Jesus returned to Capernaum, that the people received Him: for they all waited for Him.

⁴¹ And pay attention, there came a man named Jairus -- the ruler of the Synagogue, who fell down at Jesus' feet, and asked Him that He would come to his house.

⁴² For he had a daughter only, about twelve years of age, and she lay dying. And as He went, a massive crowd crammed about Him.

- ⁴³ And a woman having an issue of blood, for twelve years, who spent all she had upon physicians, and could not be healed of any:
- ⁴⁴ when she came behind Him, she touched the hem of His garment, and instantly her issue of blood stopped.
- ⁴⁵ Then Jesus said, Who touched Me? When they all denied it, Peter and those who were with him said, Master, the crowd pushed You, and stepped on your feet, and You ask, Who touched Me?
- ⁴⁶ And Jesus said, Somebody touched Me: for I know power has gone out from Me.



- ⁴⁷ When the woman saw she was exposed, she came full of fear, and fell down before Him, and in the presence of all the people: told why she had touched Him, and how she was instantly healed.
- ⁴⁸ And He said, Daughter, be of good comfort: your faith has saved you: go in peace.
- 49 While He spoke to her, one from the Synagogue leader's house, said, Your daughter is dead: don't bother the Master anymore.
- ⁵⁰ When Jesus heard it, He said to him, Do not fear: only believe, and she will be saved.
- ⁵¹ And when He entered the house, he let no one go with Him, except Peter, James, John, and the child's father and mother.
- ⁵² Everyone was crying, and sorrowed for her: but he said, Stop crying: because she is not dead, but sleeps.
- ⁵³ And they cynically laughed at Him, because they knew she was dead.
- ⁵⁴ So He threw them all out, and took her by the hand, and called out, Child, get up!
- ⁵⁵ And her spirit returned, and she got up at once: and He told them to give her some food.
- ⁵⁶ Her parents were astonished: but He instructed them to tell no one what happened.
