MATTHEW 13 vs 1



Matthew was an eyewitness to Jesus next he writes about what he remembered happened after Jesus taught the growing numbers who gathered around Him, who were truly His brothers, and sisters and mother – whoever did the will of His Father in heaven.

- ¹ On that same day Jesus went from the house, and sat by the seashore.
- ² And great multitudes gathered to Him, so that He got into a boat, and sat down; and the whole multitude stood along the seashore.



- ³ And He spoke many things to them in parables, saying, Behold, a sower went out to sow;
- ⁴ and as he sowed, some seeds fell beside the path, and birds came and ate them up:
- ⁵ and some fell upon rocky places, where they did not have much soil: and immediately they sprang up, because they had no depth of soil:
- ⁶ and when the sun had risen, they were scorched; and because they had no root, they withered away.
- ⁷ And some fell among thorns; and the thorns sprang up, and choked them:
- $^{\rm 8}$ and others fell on good soil, and brought forth fruit, some a hundredfold, some sixty, and some thirty.
- ⁹ Whoever has ears, let him hear.
- ¹⁰ And the disciples came, and said to Him, Why do you speak to them in parables?
- ¹¹ And He answered and said to them, To you it is given to know the mysteries of the kingdom of heaven, but to them it is not given.
- 12 For whoever has, to him will more be given, and he will have an abundance: but whoever has not, from him will be taken away even what he has.
- ¹³ Therefore I speak to them in parables: because while seeing they do not see; and while hearing they do not hear, nor do they understand.
- ¹⁴ And in their case the prophecy of Isaiah is being fulfilled, who said, You will continue hearing, but will not understand; and you will continue seeing, but will not perceive:

¹⁵ For the heart of these people has become dull, and with their ears they hardly hear, and they have closed their eyes; lest at any time they should see with their eyes and hear with their ears, and should understand with their heart, and return, and I should heal them.

¹⁶ But blessed are your eyes, because they see: and your ears, because they hear / said differently, unlike others, you are marked with God's favor, because your eyes see, and your ears hear.

¹⁷ For truly I say to you, That many prophets and righteous men have desired to see what vou see, and did not see it; and to hear what you hear, and did not hear it.

¹⁸So hear the parable of the sower.

¹⁹ When any one hears the word of the kingdom, and does not understand, then comes the wicked one, and takes away what was sown in his heart. This is the one who received seed by the way side.

²⁰ And the one on whom was sown seed on the rocky places, this is the man who hears the word, and immediately receives it with joy:

²¹ yet he has no firm root in himself, but is only temporary: for when affliction or persecution arises because of the word, immediately he is offended.

²² And the one on whom seed was sown among thorns is the man who hears the word; and the care of this world, and the deceitfulness of riches, choke the word, and it becomes unfruitful.

²³ But the one on whom seed was sown on the good soil, this is the one who hears the word, and understand it; who also bears fruit, and brings forth, some a hundredfold, some sixty, some thirty.
