MATTHEW 14 vs 1



Matthew was an eyewitness to Jesus next he writes about what he remembered happened after Jesus taught the parables about the Sower, the wheat and the tares, the mustard seed, and the Leaven as Jesus taught to the growing numbers who gathered around Him.

- ¹ At that time Herod the tetrarch heard of the fame of Jesus,
- ² And said to his servants, This is John the Baptist; he is risen from the dead; and so mighty works do show forth themselves in Him / people like to boast about Herod the great; but he was a paranoid freak who killed his own sons. Whatever opinion he had to offer is not of any import.



- ³ For Herod had seized John, and bound him, and put him in prison concerning Herodias, his brother Philip's wife.
- ⁴ For John said to him, It is not lawful for you to have her.
- ⁵ And though he wanted to put him to death, he feared the multitude, because they considered him as a prophet.
- $^{\rm 6}\,\rm But$ when it was the birthday of Herod, the daughter of Herodias danced before them, and pleased Herod.
- ⁷ And so he promised with an oath to give her whatever she wanted.
- ⁸ And she, having been instructed by her mother, said, Give me the head of John the Baptizer on a platter.
- ⁹ And the king was sorry: nevertheless due to his oath, and those who sat with him at dinner, he instructed it to be given her.
- ¹⁰ And he sent, and beheaded John in the prison.
- $^{11}\mathrm{And}$ his head was brought on a platter, and given to the girl: and she took it to her mother.
- ¹² And his disciples came, and took the body, and buried it, and went and told Jesus.



- ¹³ When Jesus heard of it, He withdrew from there by boat to an isolated place alone: and when the people had heard of it, they followed after Him on foot from the cities.
- 14 And Jesus went forth, and saw a great multitude, and was moved with compassion toward them, and He healed their sick.

¹⁵ And when it was evening, His disciples came to Him, saying, This is a desolate place, and the time is now past; send the multitude away, that they may go into the villages, and buy food for themselves.

 $^{16}\,\mathrm{But}$ Jesus said to them, They do not need to depart; you give them something to eat.

 17 And they said to Him, We have here only five loaves, and two fish.



¹⁸ He said, Bring them here to Me.

¹⁹ And He instructed the multitude to sit down on the grass, and took the five loaves, and the two fish, and looking up to heaven, He gave the blessing, and broke the bread, and gave the loaves to His disciples, and the disciples distributed to the multitude.



²⁰ And they all did eat, and were filled: and they gathered up the fragments that remained twelve baskets full / one for each of the disciples to ponder.

²¹ And those who had eaten were about 5,000 men, beside women and children.



- 22 And immediately Jesus compelled His disciples to get into a boat, and to go before Him to the other side, while He sent the multitudes away.
- ²³ And when He had sent the multitudes away, He went up into a mountain alone to pray: and when the evening came, He was there alone.
- ²⁴ But the boat was now in the middle of the sea of Galilee, being tossed about with waves: for the wind was turbulent / about 7 10 miles from shore.

Jesus and Peter walking on water,

- 25 And in the fourth watch of the night Jesus went to them, walking on the sea. / around 3am
- ²⁶ And when the disciples saw Him walking on the sea, they were frightened, saying, It is a spirit; and they cried out in fear.
- ²⁷ But immediately Jesus spoke to them, saying, Take courage; it is I; don't be afraid.
- ²⁸ And Peter answered Him and said, Lord, if it is You, bid me come to you on the water.
- ²⁹ And He said, Come. And when Peter got out of the boat, he walked on the water, to go to Jesus.

 36 And asked Him that they might only touch the hem of His garment: and as many as touched were made perfectly whole.
