## MATTHEW 17 vs 1



Matthew was an eyewitness to Jesus next he writes about what he remembered happened after Jesus honored His disciples with the knowledge they would be given the keys of the kingdom, and have the tools to lock or unlock the things that pertain to the things of God..



- <sup>1</sup> And after six days Jesus takes Peter, James, and John his brother, and brings them alone to a high mountain,
- <sup>2</sup> And was transfigured before them: and His face shined as the sun, and His raiment was white as the light.
- <sup>3</sup> And, behold, there appeared to them Moses and Elijah talking with Him.



- <sup>4</sup> Then Peter answered, and said to Jesus, Lord, it is good for us to be here: if it is Your will, let us make here three tabernacles; one for You, one for Moses, and one for Elijah.
- <sup>5</sup> While he yet spoke, indeed, a bright cloud overshadowed them: and behold a voice from the cloud, which said, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased; hear Him.
- <sup>6</sup> And when the disciples heard it, they fell on their face, and were very much afraid.
- <sup>7</sup> And Jesus came and touched them, and said, Arise, do not be afraid.
- <sup>8</sup> And when they lifted up their eyes, they saw no one, except Jesus.



- <sup>9</sup> And as they descended the mountain, Jesus instructed them, saying, Tell the vision to no one, until the Son of Man rises again from the dead.
- $^{10}$  And His disciples asked Him, saying, Why do the scribes say that Elijah must come first?
- <sup>11</sup> And Jesus answered and said to them, Elijah truly will come first, and restore all things.
- <sup>12</sup> But I say to you, That Elijah has already come, and they did not recognize him, but have done to him whatever they desired. Likewise the Son of Man will also suffer by them.
- <sup>13</sup> Then the disciples understood that He spoke to them of John the Baptist.
- <sup>14</sup> And when they returned to the multitude, there came a certain man to Him, kneeling down before Him, and saying,
- $^{15}$ Lord, have mercy on my son: for he is a lunatic, and very troubled: for often he falls into the fire, and frequently into the water.

<sup>16</sup> And I brought him to Your disciples, but they could not cure him.

<sup>17</sup> Then Jesus answered and said, O faithless and perverse generation, how long will I be with you? how long will I put up with you? bring him here to Me.

 $^{18}\,\mathrm{And}$  Jesus rebuked the demon; and he departed from him: and the child was cured that very hour.



<sup>19</sup> Then the disciples came to Jesus alone, and said, Why could we not cast him out?

<sup>20</sup> And Jesus said to them, Because of your unbelief: for truly I say to you, If you have faith as a grain of mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, Remove from here to another place; and it will remove; and nothing will be impossible to you.

<sup>21</sup> However this kind does not go out except by prayer and fasting.

<sup>22</sup> And while they stayed in Galilee, Jesus said to them, The Son of Man will be betrayed into the hands of evil men:

<sup>23</sup> and they will kill him, and the third day He will be raised again. And they were exceeding sorry.



<sup>24</sup> And when they came to Capernaum, those who received tax money came to Peter, and said, Doesn't your master pay the foreigner tax?

<sup>25</sup> He said, Yes. And when he entered the house, Jesus spoke first to him, saying, Simon, what do you think? from whom do the kings of the earth take custom or taxes? from their own children, or from strangers?

 $^{26}$  Peter said to Hm, from strangers. Jesus said to him, Then the children are exempt.

<sup>27</sup> Yet, lest we should offend them, go to the sea, and throw in a hook, and take the first fish that comes up; and when you open its mouth, you will find a coin; take it and give it to them for Me and you.
