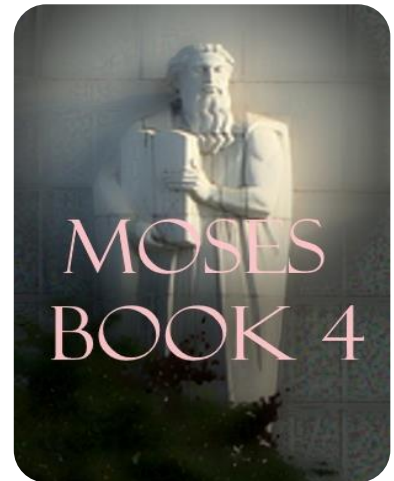

In the preface to this Book of Moses we read: The titles of the five books of Moses, which we use in our Bibles, are all borrowed from the Greek translation of the Seventy, the most ancient version of the Old Testament what we know of. But the title of this book we only turn into English; in all the rest we retain the Greek word, for which difference I know no reason, but that the Latin translators have done the same. Otherwise this book might as well have been called: **Arithmoi**. Where we get our word: **arithmetic**. The Greek title = the numbering; as it shows the promise of God to Abraham that his children would be as the stars of heaven. In this book are two numberings: one at Mount Sinai in Arabia – chapter 1; and the other on the plains of Moab 39 years later. -- Matthew Henry.



Being Led By God

¹ And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying,

² Make two trumpets of silver; of hammered work you will make them: that you use them for calling of the assembly, and for moving the camps.

³ And when both are blown, all the assembly will gather themselves to you at the doorway of the tent of meeting.

⁴ Yet if only one trumpet is blown, then the leaders, who are heads of the thousands of Israel, will gather themselves to you.

⁵ When you blow an alarm, then the camps that are on the east side will move out.

⁶ When you blow an alarm the second time, then the camps that are on the south side will move out: an alarm is blown for them to move.

⁷ But when a meeting is convened, you will blow, but not sound an alarm.

⁸ And the priestly sons of Aaron, will blow the trumpets; and this will be for you a perpetual ordinance throughout your generations.

⁹ And if you go to war in your land against the enemy who oppresses you, then you will sound an alarm with the trumpets; that you may be remembered before the LORD your God, and be saved from your enemies.

¹⁰ Also in the day of your gladness, and on your appointed days, and on the first days of your months, you will blow with the trumpets over your burnt offerings, and over the sacrifices of your peace offerings; and they will be a reminder of you before your God:
I am the LORD your God.

The March to Kadesh-Barnea

¹¹ And it happened on the second year, in the second month, on the twentieth day of the month, that the cloud was lifted from off the tent of the testimony.

¹² And the children of Israel moved on their journey from the wilderness of Sinai; and the cloud settled in the wilderness of Paran.

¹³ So for the first time they moved according to the command of the LORD by the hand of Moses.

¹⁴ And the flag of the children of Judah according to their armies, set out first with Nahshon the son of Amminadab over its army.

¹⁵ And Nethanel the son of Zuar, over the army of the tribe of the children of Issachar.

¹⁶ And Eliab the son of Helon over the army of the tribe of the children of Zebulun.

¹⁷ Then the tent was taken down; and the sons of Gershon and the sons of Merari set out carrying the tent.

¹⁸ Next the flag of the camp of Reuben according to their armies set out with Elizur the son of Shedeur over its army.

¹⁹ And Shelumiel the son of Zurishaddai over the army of the tribe of the children of Simeon.

²⁰ And Eliasaph the son of Deuel was over the army of the tribe of the children of Gad.

²¹ Then the Kohathites set out, carrying the holy things: and the tent was set up before they arrived.

²² Next the flag of the camp of the children of Ephraim according to their armies set out : with Elishama the son of Ammihud over its army.

²³ And Gamaliel the son of Pedahzur was over the army of the tribe of the children of Manasseh.

²⁴ And Abidan the son of Gideoni was over the army of the tribe of the children of Benjamin.

²⁵ Then the flag of the camp of the children of Dan, which was the rear guard for all the camps set out: and Ahiezer the son of Ammishaddai was over its army.

²⁶ And Pagiel the son of Ochran was over the army of the tribe of the children of Asher.

²⁷ And Ahira the son of Enan was over the army of the tribe of the children of Naphtali.

²⁸ Thus were the marching orders of the children of Israel according to their armies, when they set out.

²⁹ Then Moses said to Hobab, the son of Reuel the Midianite, Moses' father-in-law, We are moving out to the place the LORD said, I will give it you: come with us, and we will do you good: for the LORD has promised good concerning Israel.

³⁰ But he said to him, I will not come; but will go to my own land, and to my relatives.

³¹ Then he said, Do not leave us, I pray you; indeed as you know where we should camp in the wilderness, and you will be as eyes for us.

³² And it will be, if you go with us, yes, it will be, that the good the LORD will do to us, the same we will do to you.

³³ And they set out from the mount of the LORD three days' journey: and the ark of the covenant of the LORD went before them in the three days' journey, to search out a resting place for them.

³⁴ And the cloud of the LORD was over them by day, when they moved from the camp.

³⁵ And it happened, when the ark set out, that Moses said, Rise up, LORD, and let Your enemies be scattered; and let those who hate You flee before You.

³⁶ And when it rested, he said, Return, O LORD, to the myriad thousands of Israel.
