

In the preface to this Book of Moses we read: The titles of the five books of Moses, which we use in our Bibles, are all borrowed from the Greek translation of the Seventy, the most ancient version of the Old Testament what we know of. But the title of this book we only turn into English; in all the rest we retain the Greek word, for which difference I know no reason, but that the Latin translators have done the same. Otherwise this book might as well have been called: Arithmoi. Where we get our word: arithmetic. The Greek title = the numbering; as it shows the promise of God to Abraham that his children would be as the stars of heaven. In this book are two numberings: one at Mount Sinai in Arabia – chapter 1; and the other on the plains of Moab 39 years later. -- Matthew Henry.



Laws About Offerings

- ¹ And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying,
- ² Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them, When you be come into the land of your habitations, which I give to you,
- ³ and make an offering by fire from the herd or from the flock to the LORD; a burnt offering or a sacrifice to fulfill a special vow, or a freewill offering, or on your high holy days, making a sweet aroma to the LORD:
- ⁴ the one who presents his offering to the LORD will bring a grain offering of one-tenth / about 2 quarts of fine flour mixed with one-fourth / about 2 pints of a hin of oil.
- ⁵ And one-fourth / about 2 pints of a hin of wine for a drink offering you will prepare with the burnt offering or sacrifice, for each lamb.
- ⁶ Or for a ram, you prepare for a grain offering two-tenths / about 4 quarts of fine flour mixed with one-third of a hin of oil.
- ⁷ And for a drink offering you will offer one-third of a hin of wine, for a sweet aroma to the LORD.
- ⁸ And when you prepare a bull for a burnt offering, or for a sacrifice to fulfill a vow, or peace offerings to the LORD:
- 9 then you will offer with the bull a grain offering of three-tenths of fine flour mixed with one-half a hin of oil,
- ¹⁰ and you bring for a drink offering one-half a hin of wine, as an offering made by fire, as a sweet aroma to the LORD.



- ¹¹ This will be done for each bull, or for each ram, or for each male lamb, or each goat / so, as the Lord provides large or small, His people were to respond, not with empty hands and lots of platitudes; but in kind: not tipping the Lord with our pennies while He has provided so much; but in a way that shows His value, that with joy and gladness of heart honors His Name.
- ¹² According to the number of offerings you prepare, so you will do to each, however many.
- ¹³ All who are citizens of the country will do these things this way, presenting an offering made by fire, as a sweet aroma to the LORD.
- ¹⁴ If a foreigner travels with you, or anyone lives with you in your generations to come, he must present an offering made by fire, of a sweet aroma to the LORD; as you do, so will he;
- ¹⁵ one law will be for the assembly and for the foreigner living among you; a law throughout your generations: as you are, so will the foreigner be before the LORD.
- ¹⁶ One and the same law will be for you, and for the foreigner who lives among you.
- ¹⁷ And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying,
- ¹⁸ Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them, When you come into the land where I bring you,
- ¹⁹ then it will be, when you eat of the food of the land, you will lift up an offering to the LORD.
- 20 Of the first of your dough, you will lift up a cake as an offering: as the offering of the threshing floor, so you will lift it up.
- 21 From the first of your dough you will give to the LORD an offering throughout your generations.
- 22 But if you make a mistake, and do not observed all the instructions the LORD spoke to Moses,
- 23 even all the LORD instructed you by the hand of Moses, from the day the LORD instructed Moses, and after this among your generations;
- ²⁴ then, if it is committed by ignorance outside the knowledge of the gathering, that all the gathering will offer one young bull for a burnt offering, for a sweet aroma to the LORD, with its grain offering, and its drink offering, according to the ordinance, and one goat for a sin offering.



²⁵ Then the priest will make atonement for all the gathering of the children of Israel, and the error will be forgiven them: and they will bring their offering, a sacrifice made by fire to the LORD, and their sin offering before the LORD, for their error:

²⁶ and it will be forgiven all the assembly of the children of Israel, and the foreigner who lives among them; seeing all the people were in error.

- ²⁷ If any sins through error, then he will bring a one year old she goat for a sin offering.
- ²⁸ The priest will make an atonement for the one who sins ignorantly, when he sins by ignorance before the LORD, to make an atonement for him; and it will be forgiven him.
- ²⁹ You will have one law for the one who sins through ignorance, both for the one who is born among the children of Israel, and for the foreigner who lives among them.
- ³⁰ But the one who does defiantly, whether born in the land or a foreigner, the same blasphemes the LORD; and that one will be cut off from among his people.
- ³¹ Because he has despised the word of the LORD, and has broken His instruction, that one will be completely cut off; his guilt will be on him.
- ³² Now while the children of Israel were in the wilderness, they found a man who gathered wood on the sabbath day.
- ³³ And those who found him gathering sticks brought him to Moses and Aaron, and to all the gathering;
- ³⁴ and they put him in custody, because it was not stated what should be done to him.
- 35 Then the LORD said to Moses, The man will surely be put to death: all the gathering will stone him with stones outside the camp.
- ³⁶ So all the gathering brought him outside the camp, and stoned him to death with stones; as the LORD instructed Moses.
- ³⁷ And the LORD spoke to Moses, saving,
- ³⁸ Speak to the children of Israel, and tell them they will make for themselves, tassels on the corners of their garments throughout their generations, and that they put on the tassel of each corner a cord of blue: / and is it just me, or did somebody get creative and decide to improve on what the Lord asked?





³⁹ And it is a tassel, that you will look at, and remember all the instructions of the LORD, and do them; so you do not follow after your own evil heart and eyes, with which you prostitute yourself:

⁴⁰ that you remember, and do all My instructions, and are wholly God's.

⁴¹ I am the LORD your God, who brought you from the land of Egypt, to be your God:

And even as faithful Moses was teaching the people these things, we are reminded, that our great God takes no delight in the blood of bulls and goats. He delights in those who do His will His 10 instructions and no more. All who rehearsed those 10 instructions, found the blessing, joy and peace of God.
