In the preface to this Book of Moses we read: The titles of the five books of Moses, which we use in our Bibles, are all borrowed from the Greek translation of the Seventy, the most ancient version of the Old Testament what we know of. But the title of this book we only turn into English; in all the rest we retain the Greek word, for which difference I know no reason, but that the Latin translators have done the same. Otherwise this book might as well have been called: Arithmoi. Where we get our word: arithmetic. The Greek title = the numbering; as it shows the promise of God to Abraham that his children would be as the stars of heaven. In this book are two numberings: one at Mount Sinai in Arabia – chapter 1; and the other on the plains of Moab 39 years later. -- Matthew Henry.



The order of offerings; and high holy days; starting with daily offerings:

- <sup>1</sup> And the LORD spoke to Moses, saving,
- <sup>2</sup> Command the children of Israel, and say to them, you will observe to present My offering, and My food for My sacrifices made by fire, for a sweet aroma to Me, at their appointed time.
- <sup>3</sup> And you say to them, This is the offering by fire which you will present to the LORD; two male lambs one year old without defect, as a continual burnt offering every day.
- <sup>4</sup> You will offer one lamb in the morning, and the other lamb you will offer at evening:
- <sup>5</sup> also a tenth of an ephah of fine flour for a grain offering, mixed with a fourth of a hin of beaten oil.
- <sup>6</sup> It is a continual burnt offering, which was ordained in Mount Sinai for a sweet aroma, an offering by fire to the LORD.
- <sup>7</sup> And the drink offering with it will be a fourth of a hin for each lamb: in the holy place you will pour out a strong drink offering to the LORD.
- <sup>8</sup> And the other lamb you will offer at evening: as the grain offering of the morning, and as its drink offering, you will offer it, an offering by fire, of a sweet aroma to the LORD.
- <sup>9</sup> Then on the sabbath day two male lambs a one year old without defect, and two-tenths of fine flour mixed with oil as a grain offering, and a drink offering with it:
- <sup>10</sup> this is the burnt offering of every sabbath, in addition to the continual burnt offering, and its drink offering.

Monthly offerings,

- <sup>11</sup> Then at the beginning of each of your months you will present a burnt offering to the LORD; two bulls and one ram, seven male lambs one year old without defect;
- <sup>12</sup> and three-tenths of fine flour for a grain offering, mixed with oil, for each bull; and two-tenths of fine flour for a grain offering, mixed with oil, for each ram;
- <sup>13</sup> and a tenth of fine flour for a grain offering mixed with oil, for each lamb; for a burnt offering of sweet aroma, an offering made by fire to the LORD.
- <sup>14</sup> And their drink offerings will be half a hin of wine for a bull, and a third of a hin for a ram, and a fourth of a hin for a lamb: this is the burnt offering of each month throughout the months of the year.
- <sup>15</sup> And one male goat for a sin offering to the LORD will be presented, in addition to the continual burnt offering, and its drink offering.

Passover, and Unleavened Bread offerings (in the NT remembering when Messiah substituted His life for us, and was buried). The 7 days of the Lord, are 7 specific workdays, belonging to Him; when Messiah does something memorable. The 3 annual holidays of joy and gladness for the people center around those 7 workdays of Messiah. Moses wrote about them also in Exodus 23 & 34; Leviticus 23; Deuteronomy 16; and here.

- <sup>16</sup> Then on the fourteenth day of the first month is the **Passover** of the LORD.
- <sup>17</sup> And on the fifteenth day of the month is a feast: unleavened bread will be eaten for seven days.
- <sup>18</sup> On the first day will be a holy gathering; you will do no laborious work:
- <sup>19</sup> but you will present an offering by fire, for a burnt offering to the LORD; two bulls and one ram, and seven male lambs one year old: they will be without defect:
- <sup>20</sup> And their grain offering will be of fine flour mixed with oil: three-tenths of an ephah you will offer for a bull, and two-tenths for a ram;
- <sup>21</sup> and at least a tenth for each of the seven lambs:
- <sup>22</sup> and one male goat for a sin offering, to make atonement for you.
- <sup>23</sup> You will present these in addition to the burnt offering in the morning, which is for a continual burnt offering.

<sup>24</sup> After this manner you will present daily, for seven days, the food of the offering by fire, of a sweet aroma to the LORD: it will be presented with its drink offering, in addition to its continual burnt offering.

<sup>25</sup> And on the seventh day you will have a holy gathering; you will do no laborious work.

Firstfruits and Pentecost offerings (in the NT remembering when Messiah arose from the dead and sent His Spirit).

<sup>26</sup> Also on the day of firstfruits, when you bring a new grain offering to the LORD, after your feast of weeks, you will have a holy gathering; you will do no laborious work / 7 weeks. 50 days after the initial firstfruits was offered.

<sup>27</sup> And you will present the burnt offering for a sweet aroma to the LORD; two young bulls, one ram, seven male lambs one year old;

<sup>28</sup> and their grain offering of fine flour mixed with oil, three-tenths for each bull, twotenths for a ram,

<sup>29</sup> and at least a tenth for each of the seven lambs;

<sup>30</sup> And one male goat, to make atonement for you.

<sup>31</sup> In addition to the continual burnt offering, (they will be without defect), you will present them with its grain offering, and drink offering.
