

But the title of this book we only turn into English; in all the rest we retain the Greek word, for which difference I know no reason, but that the Latin translators have done the same. Otherwise this book might as well have been called: Arithmoi. Where we get our word: arithmetic. The Greek title = the numbering; as it shows the promise of God to Abraham that his children would be as the stars of heaven. In this book are two numberings: one at Mount Sinai in Arabia – chapter 1; and the other on the plains of Moab 39 years later. -- Matthew Henry.



Transjordan Settled by two the tribes,

- <sup>1</sup> Now the children of Reuben and the children of Gad had a very large number of cattle: and when they saw the land of Jazer, and the land of Gilead, that indeed, it was a place appropriate for cattle;
- <sup>2</sup> then the children of Gad and the children of Reuben came and spoke to Moses, and to Eleazar the priest, and to the leaders of the assembly, saying,
- <sup>3</sup> Ataroth, Dibon, Jazer, Nimrah, Heshbon, Elealeh, Shebam, Nebo, and Beon,
- <sup>4</sup> even the land which the LORD conquered before the assembly of Israel, is a land for cattle, and Your servants have cattle:
- <sup>5</sup> And they said, if we have found favor in your sight, let this land be given to your servants for a possession, and do not have us cross over the Jordan.
- <sup>6</sup> But Moses said to the children of Gad and to the children of Reuben, Will your relatives go to war, and you sit here?
- <sup>7</sup> Why do you discourage the heart of the children of Israel from going over to the land which the LORD has given them?
- <sup>8</sup> Thus did your fathers, when I sent them from Kadesh-barnea to see the land.
- <sup>9</sup> For when they went up to the valley of Eshcol, and saw the land, they discouraged the heart of the children of Israel, so that they did not enter into the land which the LORD had given them.
- <sup>10</sup> And the anger of the LORD was ignited that same day, and He pledged, saving,



- <sup>11</sup> Surely none of the men who came up from Egypt, from twenty years old and upward, will see the land which I pledged to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob; for they did not follow Me totally:
- 12 except Caleb the son of Jephunneh the Kenizzite, and Joshua the son of Nun: for they have totally followed the LORD.
- <sup>13</sup> And the anger of the LORD was ignited against Israel, and He made them wander in the wilderness forty years, until the entire generation, that did evil in the sight of the LORD, was destroyed.
- <sup>14</sup> And indeed, you have risen up in the place of your fathers, a bunch of sinful men, to increase the fierce anger of the LORD toward Israel.
- <sup>15</sup> For if you turn away from Him, He will once again abandon them in the wilderness; and you will destroy all these people.
- <sup>16</sup> Then they came near him, and said, We will build sheepfolds here for our cattle, and cities for our little ones:
- <sup>17</sup> but we ourselves will be armed, ready to go before the children of Israel, until we have brought them to their place: while our little ones dwell in fortified cities because of the inhabitants of the land.
- <sup>18</sup> We will not return to our homes, until the children of Israel possess his inheritance.
- <sup>19</sup> For we will not have inheritance with them on the other side of Jordan and beyond; because our inheritance has fallen to us on this side of the Jordan eastward.
- <sup>20</sup> So Moses said to them, If you will do this, if you will go armed before the LORD to war,
- <sup>21</sup> and all of you armed men cross over the Jordan before the LORD, until He has driven out His enemies from before Him,
- <sup>22</sup> and the land is subdued before the LORD: then afterward you will return, and not be obligated before the LORD and before Israel; and this land will be yours for a possession before the LORD.
- <sup>23</sup> But if you will not do so, behold, you have sinned against the LORD: and be sure your sin will find you out.
- <sup>24</sup> Build cities for your little ones, and folds for your sheep; and do what you have promised.



- <sup>25</sup> And the children of Gad and the children of Reuben spoke to Moses, saying, Your servants will do just as my lord commands.
- <sup>26</sup> Our little ones, our wives, our flocks, and all our cattle, will be there in the cities of Gilead:
- <sup>27</sup> while your servants, everyone who is armed for war, will pass over, before the LORD to battle, just as my lord says.
- <sup>28</sup> So Moses gave command concerning them to Eleazar the priest, and Joshua the son of Nun, and the heads of their father's household of the tribes of the children of Israel:
- <sup>29</sup> and Moses said to them, If the children of Gad and the children of Reuben will cross over Jordan with you, every man armed to battle, before the LORD, and the land is subdued before you; then you will give them the land of Gilead for a possession:
- <sup>30</sup> but if they will not cross over with you armed, they must share possessions among you in the land of Canaan.
- <sup>31</sup> And the children of Gad and the children of Reuben answered, saying, As the LORD has said to your servants, so we will do.
- <sup>32</sup> We will cross over armed in the presence of the LORD into the land of Canaan, that the possession of our inheritance on this side of the Jordan may be ours.
- <sup>33</sup> And Moses gave to them, even to the children of Gad, and to the children of Reuben, and to the half-tribe of Manasseh the son of Joseph, the kingdom of Sihon king of the Amorites, and the kingdom of Og king of Bashan, the land with their cities to its borders, even the cities of the surrounding land / remember, Manasseh the oldest son of Joseph, was ½ Egyptian; he and his brother **Ephraim** who carries the birthright promise given first to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, then to Ephraim – these 2 brothers were given additional promises: Manasseh would be a great nation in the last days; and Ephraim would be a great commonwealth of nations - both would be at the center of the earth.
- <sup>34</sup> And the children of Gad built Dibon, and Ataroth, and Aroer,
- 35 and Atroth-shophan, and Jazer, and Jogbehah,
- <sup>36</sup> and Beth-nimrah, and Beth-haran, fortified cities: and sheepfolds for sheep.
- <sup>37</sup> And the children of Reuben built Heshbon, and Elealeh, and Kiriathaim,
- <sup>38</sup> and Nebo, and Baal-meon, (their names being changed,) and Sibmah: and gave other names to the cities which they built.



- <sup>39</sup> And the children of Machir the son of Manasseh went to Gilead, and took it, and dispossessed the Amorite who were in it.
- <sup>40</sup> So Moses gave Gilead to Machir the son of Manasseh; and he lived in it.
- <sup>41</sup> And Jair the son of Manasseh went and took its small towns, and called them Havvoth-jair.
- <sup>42</sup> And Nobah went and took Kenath, and its villages, and called it Nobah, after his name.
