¹ Paul, a prisoner of Jesus Christ, and Timothy our brother, to Philemon the beloved, and our coworker,

² and to Apphia our sister, and Archippus our fellow soldier, and to the church at your house:

³Grace to you, and peace, from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

⁴I thank my God, making mention of you always in my prayers,



⁵ because I her of your love for all the saints, and the faith you have toward the Lord Jesus;

⁶ I pray that your shared common faith may become effective through knowing every good thing that is in us for the glory of Christ Jesus.

⁷ For I have great joy and strength in your love, because the hearts of the saints are refreshed through you, brother.

⁸ For this reason, although I have great confidence in Christ to instruct you to do what is proper,

⁹ yet through love I urge you, since I Paul as an old man, and now also a prisoner of Jesus Christ.

¹⁰ I urge you for my son Onesimus, whom I fathered while I was in chains.

¹¹Once he was useless to you, but now he is useful both to you and to me:

¹² I am sending him back to you – who is my very own heart: so receive him:

¹³ I wanted to keep him with me, so that in my confinement for the gospel, might serve me in you on behalf of you:

¹⁴ But without your consent I would not do it; so that your good deed would not be out of obligation, but your own free will.

¹⁵ Perhaps this is why he was separated from you for a short time, so that you might get him back forever;

¹⁶ no longer as a slave, but more than a servant: a beloved brother, especially to me, but how much more to you, both in the flesh, and in the Lord?

¹⁷ So if you consider me as a partner, welcome him as you would me.

¹⁸ If he has wronged you, or owes you, charge that to my account;

- $^{19}\,\mathrm{I}$ Paul write this with my own hand, I will repay it -- not to mention to you that you own me your own self .
- ²⁰ Yes, brother, may I find joy from you in the Lord: refresh my heart in the Lord.
- $^{21}\,\mathrm{Since}\;I$ am confident in your obedience, so I write to you, knowing you will do more than I say.
- 22 In the meantime, prepare a guest room for me: for I hope that through your prayers I will be restored to you.
- ²³ Epaphras, my fellow prisoner in Christ Jesus; sends you greetings,
- ²⁴ as do Mark, Aristarchus, Demas and Luke, my coworkers.
