These Proverbs were first read by the royal families; the House of Judah, who were the Praise of God; and the House of Israel those who claimed to be Ruled by God. In them, you clearly find the path of royalty juxtaposed with the path of royal jackasses -both small and great. it is crystal clear royalty and people of privilege fell off the wagon; nevertheless, the Proverbs still speak to the way of the wrong, as well as the way of the right.

of little use - Matthew Henry. Solomon, for being a smart guy, he was pretty stupid. So many scholars love to point out Solomon spoke 3,000 proverbs and 1,005 songs. Hmm? When did he have time to be a thoughtful king? They fail to point out: Solomon had 700 wives and 300 girlfriends - 1 Kings 11. And you wonder, when did he have time to be a thoughtful father and king? We know he ended his life saying: he played the fool. We know most of the kingdom was taken from him... and then he died - since he had done evil in the sight of the Lord.

1 Does not wisdom call? / in this chapter, Wisdom is mentioned 5 times, it has already been mentioned 18 times and after this chapter 32 more times; the ancient Job said; Behold, the fear of the Lord is wisdom - Job 28:28. Paul declared: Jesus is the Wisdom of God - 1 Corinthians 1; something that absolutely sounds foolish, to thoughtless, heartless man. Dr. Dallas Willard, philosophy professor at USC, said Jesus is still the wisest man ever to influence mankind; His name is known in every nation, His praise is declared in every language group; 6,000,000,000 Bibles will be purchased this year because of Him. Without Him, the Western nations would not have known such ascendancy in power and influence.

And Paul said: we who follow Christ -- the Messiah of God are to put on Christ. The best way to do that is: learn what Jesus said; take to heart the many things He said; hide them in our hearts.

⁷ For My mouth speaks truth; and wickedness is an abomination to My lips.

- ⁸ All the words of My mouth are right; there is nothing crooked or perverse in them / nothing is twisted in them... so Divine Wisdom is different from what hocus pocus people with their thugs and criminals serve up in their daily talking point BS de jour.
- ⁹ They are all plain to him who understands, and right to those who find knowledge / He knows best how to describe what is going on; the Lord God does not stutter, He does not have a difficult time communicating; He is not trying to tell us something. If there is a difficulty in the communication it is on our side; it is in our listening; and we better understand, we need to know what the Creator tells us since He speaks truth, and is not speaking rocket science; His words are true.
- ¹⁰ Take my instruction, and not silver; and take knowledge and not gold.
- ¹¹For wisdom is better than rubies; no treasure can compare to it.
- ¹² I, Wisdom have intelligence, and I find knowledge and insight.
- ¹³ The fear of the LORD is to hate evil: pride, arrogance, the evil way, and the perverted mouth -- I hate.
- ¹⁴Counsel and sound wisdom are Mine: I Am understanding; I have power.
- ¹⁵ By Me, kings reign, and rulers decree justice / notice, the word says: justice, not injustice; not unequal law; not one law for one group, and another law for an elite group putting some in a group above the law; who are sure the law applies to someone else.
- ¹⁶ By Me, princes rule, and nobles, all who govern the earth.
- ¹⁷ I love them who love Me; and those who diligently seek Me will find Me.
- ¹⁸ Riches and honor are with Me; yes, enduring riches and rightness.
- ¹⁹ My fruit is better than gold, yes, than pure gold; and My payout better than fine silver.
- 20 I lead in the way of rightness, in the midst of the paths of justice:
- 21 to endow those who love Me with substance; that I may fill their treasuries.

- ²²The LORD possessed Me at the beginning of His way, before His works of old.
- ²³ From everlasting I was set up, from the beginning, from the earliest time of the earth.
- ²⁴ When there were no depths, I was brought forth; when there were no springs abounding with water.
- ²⁵ Before the mountains were settled, before the hills I was brought forth:
- ²⁶ when He had not yet made the earth and the fields, nor the first dust of the world.
- ²⁷When He established the heavens, I was there: when He inscribed a circle on the face of the deep -- there:
- ²⁸ when He made firm the skies above: when the springs of the deep were fixed there, there:

- ³² So now, O children, listen to Me: for blessed are those who keep My ways / these word were first spoken to Adam in the Garden of Eden; they were spoken by Jesus to His followers the night He was betrayed; and they last describe the small congregation in Philadelphia, who actually did what He said.
- ³³ Hear instruction, and be wise, and do not neglect it.
- 34 Blessed is the one who listens to Me, watching daily at My gates, waiting at My doorpost.
- ³⁵ For whoever finds Me finds life, and obtains favor from the LORD.
- ³⁶ But he who sins against Me, wrongs himself: all who hate Me love death.
