A Psalm of David

¹ The LORD says to my Lord,

...the LORD God says to David's Lord -- to the promised Messiah; it is with this verse that Jesus finally silenced the arrogant religious hard-heads during the time He lived among us... who did not appreciate His influence on the multitudes; who were relentless to catch Him in error. They could not answer His question regarding the Christ / the Messiah, why did David call Him Lord? -- Matthew 22.

Since they all knew the proverbs, He could have asked: Who has ascended to heaven, or descended? Who has gathered the wind in His fist? Who has established the ends of the earth? What is His name; and His Son's name, if you can tell? -- Proverbs 30... but He didn't have time.

The LORD says to my Lord, "Sit at My right hand,

until I make Your foes Your footstool."

² The LORD sends out from Zion the rod of Your strength:

"Rule amid Your foes".

To do whatever He asks

³ Your people will be willing on the day of Your power:

You, always beautiful,

always holy from the womb:

always refreshing as dew from the dawn of Your youth.

⁴ The LORD has sworn, and will not change,

You are Priest forever after the orderliness of Melchizedek / He alone is our only Priest; no one else to mediate is needed.

The Lord at Your right hand... will shatter kings on the Day of wrath / starting with the son of perdition; that man of lawlessness, that little horn of power that Daniel told us about, will be shattered; it will be ugly – Dr. Dallas Willard reminds us, when we enter a room and turn on a light, the darkness

immediately disappears; so also, the Lord of glory will destroy him... simply by His appearing. Then He'll go after the 10 kings – those vapid royal jackasses who gave their allegiance and resources to the last beast govt gone wild – *drunk with the blood of the saints and martyrs of Jesus* – Rev. 17. Done√

He will execute judgment among the nations, / the kings of the earth, the great moguls; the commanders, the rich, the strong, and every slave and free man... who thought they could run and hide in the caves and amid the rocks – Rev. 6; obviously none of them read what the fig-picker wrote: *though they dig into hell, My hand will take them; though they ascend to the heavens, I will bring them down* – Amos 9.

He will execute judgment among the nations, filling them with corpses; Done√

He will shatter the great head of earth / Wow! Even fulfilling His promise to the serpent, that father of lies... who was a murderer from the beginning; mission accomplished: *He will crush your head* -- Genesis 3. Done✓

And coming down the Mount of Olives from where He left those few who followed Him 2000 years ago... passing over the Kidron toward the Eastern Gate that anxiously awaits His glorious arrival; only pausing briefly on His way to prove: *The Word of God stands forever...* as Hudson Taylor learned: there is a God in heaven; He has spoken in His Word; He means what He says; and intends to do all He promised... yes, He really returned; and since He's been busy visiting all those fools; He probably broke a sweat;
