

# PSALM 110 vs 1

This Psalm is about the altogether lovely, totally victorious Messiah of God, who comes a 2<sup>nd</sup> time... to complete His work at the Ingathering of the Harvest... declared in detail by Moses to the people of God; **3 precise Days**... **shadows of things to come**... are still on His calendar; and won't the rebels be upset? This Psalm is a Check List of **things to do** for Messiah the day He comes again in power and great glory.

Division. The subject is the Priest-King; after the order of **Melchi-zedek**. The psalm describes His appointment, His followers, battles and victories; introduction (1-3); the central thought (4); and supplementary verses (5-7) – Charles Spurgeon. **Mercy = getting what we do not deserve**



## A Psalm of David

<sup>1</sup> **The LORD says to my Lord** / the LORD God says to the Lord of David,

**Sit at My right hand, until I make Your foes Your footstool.**

<sup>2</sup> **The LORD sends out from Zion the rod of Your strength: Rule amid Your foes.**

To do whatever He asks

<sup>3</sup> **Your people will be willing \_\_\_\_\_ on the day of Your power:**

**You, always beautiful, always holy from the womb: always refreshing as dew from the dawn of Your youth.**

Think about it: -- to the promised Messiah; with this verse Jesus finally silenced the arrogant hard-heads during the time He lived among us... who did not appreciate His influence on the multitudes; who were relentless to catch Him in error. They could not answer His question regarding the Messiah, **why did David call Him Lord?** -- **Matthew 22.**

Since they all knew the proverbs, He could have asked: Who has ascended to heaven, or descended? Who has gathered the wind in His fist? Who has established the ends of the earth? **What is His name; and His Son's name, if you can tell?** -- **Proverbs 30**... but He didn't have time.

**You are Priest forever after the orderliness of Melchizedek.**

Think about it: He alone is our only Priest; no one else to mediate is needed.

**<sup>5</sup>The Lord at Your right hand, will shatter kings on the Day of wrath**  
Done✓

**<sup>6</sup>He will execute justice among the nations, filling them with corpses;**  
Done✓

**He will shatter the great head of earth** Done✓

**<sup>7</sup>He will drink of the brook in the way:** Done✓

**Then, He will lift up His head.** Done✓ mission accomplished.

Think about it: Starting with the son of perdition; that lawless man, that puny horn of power that Daniel told us about, will be shattered; it will be ugly – Dr. Dallas Willard reminds us, when we enter a room and turn on a light, the darkness immediately disappears; so also, the Lord of glory will destroy him simply by His appearing. Done✓ Then He'll go after the 10 kings – royal jackasses who gave their allegiance and resources to the last govt gone wild – drunk with the blood of the saints and martyrs of Jesus – Rev. 17. Done✓

The kings of the earth, the great moguls; the commanders, the rich, the strong, and every slave and free man... who thought they could run and hide in the caves and amid the rocks – Rev. 6; Done✓ obviously none of them read what the fig-picker wrote: though they dig into hell, My hand will take them; though they ascend to the heavens, I will throw them down – Amos 9. Done✓

Wow! Messiah fulfils His promise to the serpent, heaven's choir boy, suddenly sings off key; that father of lies who was a murderer from the beginning; mission accomplished: He will crush your head -- Genesis 3. Done✓

And descending the Mount of Olives where He left those few who followed Him 2000 years ago... passing over the Kidron toward the Eastern Gate that eagerly awaits His arrival; pausing briefly on His way to prove: The Word of God stands forever; as Hudson Taylor learned: there is a God in heaven; He spoke in His Word; He means what He says; and intends to do all He promised; yes, He really returned; and has been a little busy visiting all those fools. Did He break a sweat? yes, He was a little thirsty; Done✓ And in great victory, with the biggest grin, looks up; thankful to His Father who is our Father too; to Him be the glory! Done✓
