The Seven Bowls of God's Wrath

1 Then I heard a great voice from the naos / the heart of Heaven, saying to the seven angels, Go and pour out the seven bowls of the wrath of God on the earth / so the 5th day of the Lord has taken place, because the people of God are not appointed to wrath, but to salvation through Jesus Christ



2 the first went, and poured out his bowl on the earth; and a loathsome and malignant sore broke out on those who had the mark of the beast and worshiped its image.

3 the second poured out his bowl on the sea; and it turned to blood like of a dead man: and all life in the sea died.

4 the third poured out his bowl on the rivers and springs of water; and they became blood.

5 And I heard the angel of the waters say,

You are righteous, O Lord, who is, and was, and will be, because You have judged these things.

6 Because they shed the blood of the saints and the prophets, so You have given them blood to drink; for they deserve it!

7 And I heard another from the altar say,

Even so, Lord God Almighty, true and righteous are Your judgments!

Jesus said to His followers, in the world you will have tribulation, but be courageous, I have overcome the world. We will have troubles, but we are not appointed unto His wrath.

8 the **fourth** poured out his bowl on the sun; and it was allowed **to scorch people with fire.**

9 **They were scorched with great heat,** and blasphemed the name of God, who has power over these plagues. They did **not** reconsider and give Him glory.

10 the **fifth** poured out his bowl on the throne of the beast; and its kingdom was plunged into darkness. People gnawed their tongues in anguish,

11 and blasphemed the God of heaven for their pains and sores. They did **not** rethink their deeds.

12 the **sixth** poured out his bowl on the great river Euphrates; and its water was dried up, **to prepare the way for the kings of the east.**

13 And I saw coming from the mouth of the **dragon**, and from the mouth of the **beast**, and from the mouth of the **false prophet...**

three **unclean spirits like frogs** / in other words: what everybody in the world thought were brilliant, laudable political and spiritual leaders, all John saw was **3 croaking fools.**

14 For they are **demonic spirits, working miracles, who go out to the kings of the earth of the whole world, to assemble them for battle on the great day of God Almighty.** / more likely who go out to the royal jackasses

The Lord God Almighty gives us a parenthesis to think about; He says...

15 **Look, I come like a thief! Blessed is he who stays alert, keeping his clothes, so he not go around naked, and see his shame** / when He comes it will be quite unexpected... so don't be exposed and unprepared to join Him. **As is your faith it will be done to you.** Some are sure they go through His wrath. Wow!

16 And the kings assembled at the place called in Hebrew: Armageddon.

The Seventh Bowl

17 the **seventh** poured out his bowl into the air; and a great voice came from the **naos** / the heart of Heaven of heaven, from the throne, saying, It is done / it happened; this terrifying **6th Day of the Lord**; **afflicting souls**; the Day of God's wrath; the great battle is finished; and we are not privileged to any of the blood and guts and gory reality; the Lord simply tells John:

18 There was rumbling, and thundering, and flashes of lightning; **and a severe earthquake, like no other since man was on the earth**, so great was that earthquake.

20 Every island fled, and the mountains were not to be found.

21 **And great hailstones, each stone about 100 pounds...** fell from heaven on the people: and they blasphemed God for the plague of the hail; for its plague was exceeding great / it was severe.

I'd rather sing the songs of the redeemed, who embraced His sacrifice for our sins; who substituted His life for us.
